Hometown: Maryville, Tennessee



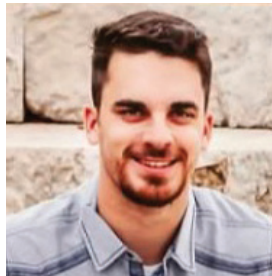
