JAZZ BAND

The Maryville College Jazz Band is an instrumental ensemble of 5-12 members. The Jazz Band performs at least one major concert each semester and explores a wide variety of jazz styles: from swing to funk to Latin grooves. Students will develop their performance skills, learn the art of improvisation, and gain a deeper understanding of jazz style, interpretation, and ensemble playing.

MC3 BAND

The MC3 Band serves a dual purpose: to provide a means of artistic expression for all its members (students, faculty, staff and community) within the wind band medium, and to provide Maryville students with the opportunity to perform and learn within a large ensemble setting. Using a traditional symphonic band instrumentation, the band performs repertoire from the entire scope of the wind band tradition.

THE ORCHESTRA AT MARYVILLE COLLEGE

The Orchestra at Maryville College (OMC) is a full symphony orchestra comprised of strings, winds, and percussion. A College and community ensemble, the OMC brings live symphonic performances to the public stage three times per season. Membership in the orchestra is open to all student orchestral musicians by audition.
