New students must demonstrate English proficiency prior to start of classes at Maryville College. We accept the following English proficiency test scores and many other options for unconditional admission:

ITEP Academic score of 3.9

PTE Academic score of 50

ACT Composite score of 24/21 English

SAT Evidence Based Read/Write: 540
